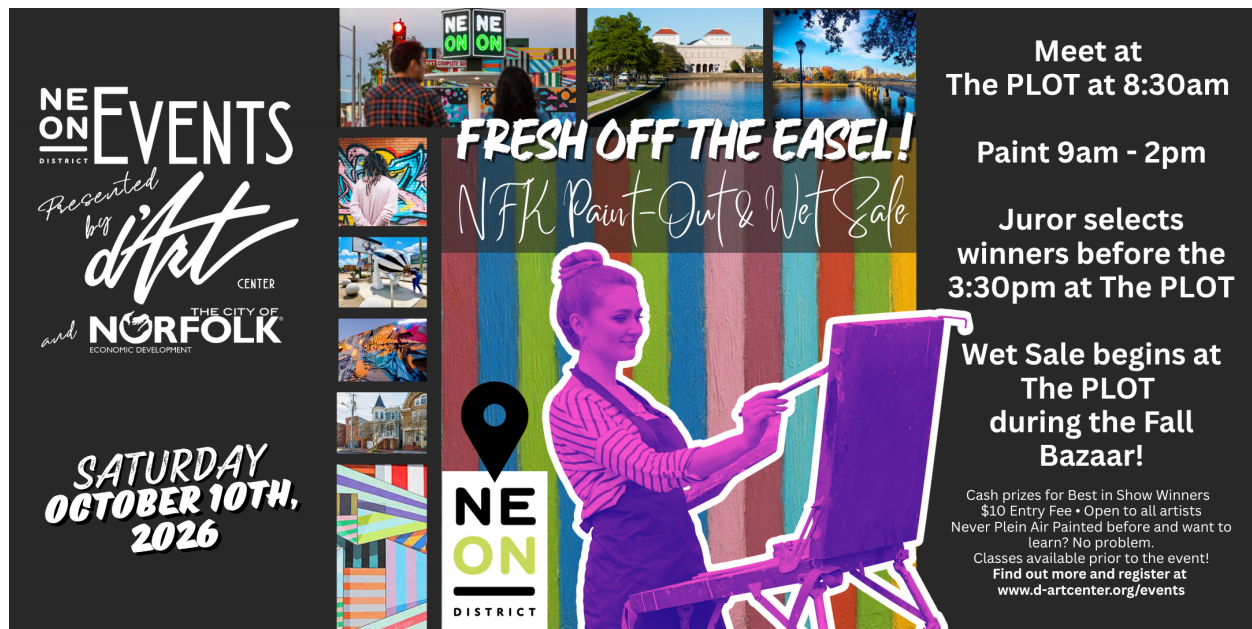




Paint-Out and Wet Sale Timeline

8:30am - 9am - Registration and Canvas Stamping

- Artists arrive at The PLOT with blank canvas, board, or paper.
- Organizers stamp the back of every blank surface to prevent pre-painted entries.

9am - 2pm - The Painting Window

- Artists scatter to paint within The NEON District. They are also encouraged to paint at The Fall Bazaar at The PLOT.
- The public is encouraged to walk around and watch the artists work and attend the Fall Bazaar at The PLOT.

2pm - 3pm - Jury & Sale Preparation

- Artists make their way back to The PLOT to prepare for the juror and the Wet Sale.
- Artists check in with the organizers at The Plot and receive a sale form to fill out to participate in the Wet Sale. Artists who want to be considered for the competition let the organizers know and receive a marker to designate their work for jurying.
- Artists set their work on their easels in the designated location at The Fall Bazaar at The Plot for Jurying and the Wet Sale. Work does not need to be framed.

- Artists must be totally set up and ready by 3pm for their work to be juried and for the Wet Sale to begin immediately following the jurors decisions. All forms must be turned in by 3pm.

3:30pm - Juror Announcement and Wet Sale Begins

- The juror selects the prize winners by 3:30pm
- The Wet Sale begins at 3:30. All sales will go through The d'Art Center. The d'Art Center will take a 25% cut of all sales.

5pm - The Wet Sale & Fall Bazaar Ends

The d'Art Center will issue checks to artists who have won awards and made sales within 15 days of the event.
